MCCCE Eager to Award \$16,000 in Scholarships

The McCracken County Community Career Endowment, Inc. (MCCCE) reminds McCracken County residents that \$16,000 is available in educational assistance for African American students and returning students. **Application deadline is March 30, 2007**.

The \$16,000 will be divided among individual awards of \$1,000 for full-time students attending, or planning to attend, a post-secondary educational or training facility; and \$500 awards for part-time students. There is also an emergency fund for education-related expenses.

To apply, residents must complete a form stating their family income, grade point average and proof of school admission, and write a brief summary of their educational and employment objectives. Forms are available from the MCCCE office at (270) 444-6962 or by e-mail at McCareersInc@aol.com.
